


# Levels of English -postgraduate



### **University Terms**

- 1. enrollment the process of registering and officially joining a course or program at a university
- 2. academic advisor a faculty member who assists students in making academic decisions, choosing courses, and planning their academic career
- syllabus a document outlining the requirements and expectations for a course
- 4. prerequisite a course that must be taken before a student can take a more advanced course
- 5. lecture a formal presentation by a professor or other expert on a specific topic
- 6. seminar a class in which students and a professor discuss and analyze a specific topic
- GPA grade point average, a measure of a student's academic performance based on their grades
- thesis a long research paper or project that is written by a student as a requirement for a degree
