there are 6 stacks of cards

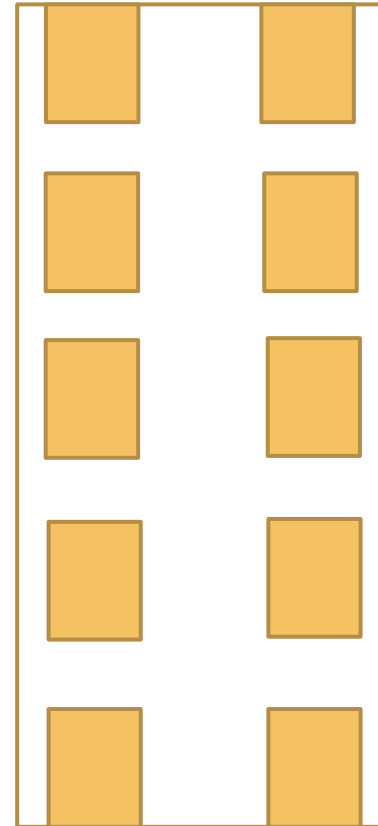
there are 10 cards in a stack

each card has an idiom's

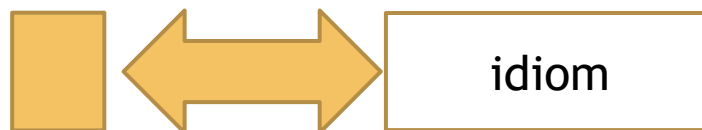
- meaning

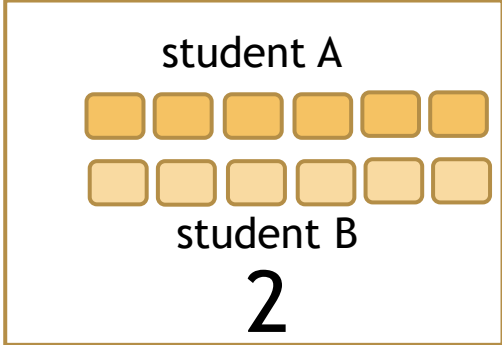
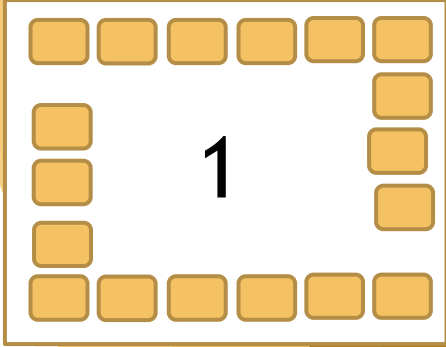
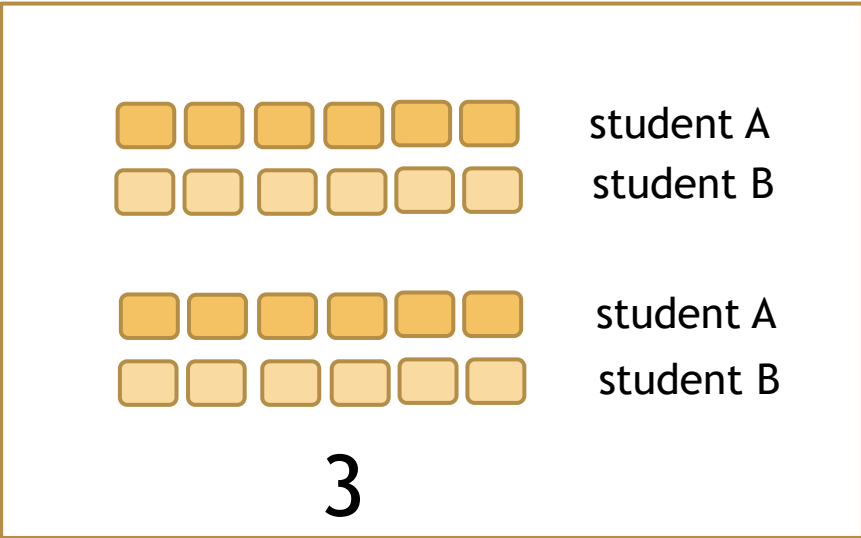

instructions

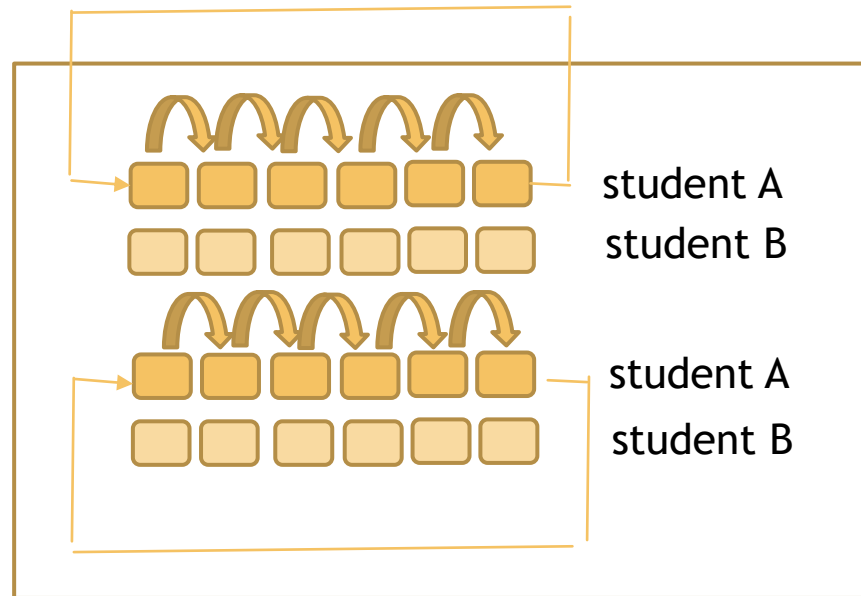
1. Move all the chairs / & tables to the side of the room
2. Put a row of 6 chairs facing 6 chairs in the middle of the room
3. Now put another rows of 6 pairs of chairs facing each other
(now have 12×2 chairs)

4. Sit

change

1. 4 groups of 6 students
2. group 1,2,3 & 4
 - 1 to 2, 3 to 4
 - 1 to 3, 2 to 4
 - 1 to 4, 2 to 3
