what is software?

a series of detailed electronic instructions

- ▶ that tell the computer how to perform a task
- ▶ that control the operation of a computer system
- ▶ translated into binary instructions (0s & 1s) for the processor
- form programs which are developed by computer programmers

System Software

serves as the interface between

▶ the user,

▶ the application software,

and the computer's hardware



system software

consists of the programs that control or maintain the operations of the computer and its devices

"a set of programs containing instructions that work together to coordinate all the activities among computer hardware resources"





network system software

network OS

- runs on a server
- gives the server the capability to manage
 - ▶ data, users, groups,
 - security, applications, and
 - other networking functions.
- allow shared file and printer access among multiple computers
- ▶ e.g. Windows Server & Novell's Netware

network system software

advantages

- ► highly stable
- security
- easy to upgrade
- ▶ remote access

disadvantages

- ► high cost
- reliance on central system
- ▶ needs regular maintenance & upgrades






Application Software

Exchanging files

- Importing: getting data from another source and then converting it into a compatible format
- Exporting: transforming data into a format that can be used in another program

Word processing software allows users to create and manipulate documents



- Enter text and numbers
- Insert images
- Perform other tasks

Create a document

Edit a document

- Make changes to existing content
- Inserting, deleting, cutting, copying, and pasting

- Change appearance
 - Font
 - Font size

Format a document

Formatting

- ► Font
 - ▶ The typeface, size, and color of the text you use
 - ► Also lets you specify underlined, italic, or bold
- ► Spacing & Columns
 - ► Choose the line spacing (single- or double-spaced, or other)
 - ► Choose single-column or multi-columned text for your document
- ► Margins & Justification
 - ▶ Indicate width of left, right, top, and bottom margins
 - ▶ Justify text left, right, or center

Headers, footers, page numbers

- ▶ A header is text printed at the very top of the page
- ▶ A footer is text (like page number) at the page bottom

Other Formatting

- ▶ You can specify borders, shading, tables, and footnotes
- ► You can also import graphics, such as clip art



Business Software

Spreadsheet software allows users to organize data in rows and columns and perform calculations



Spreadsheets


Organized into columns and rows on a worksheet

- ► Labels are descriptive text
- ▶ Cells are where a row and a column meet
- ▶ Cell address is the position of the cell
- ▶ Range is a group of adjacent cells
- ▶ Values are numbers or dates entered into a cell
- ▶ Cell pointer shows where data is to be entered

spreadsheets

Charting depicts data in a spreadsheet in graphical form

- Scatter charts, and
- Line graphs



A function is a predefined formula that performs common calculations




Business Software

A database is a collection of data organized in a manner that allows access, retrieval, and use of that data

Database software allows users to

- create,
- access, and
- manage a database



Database Software

Relational database:

data organized into related tables

- rows (records) & columns (fields)
- Primary key is field used to identify records (e.g. student ID)
- Keys are field used to index data
- Query to display records

Business Software

Presentation software allows users to create visual aids for presentations to communicate ideas, e.g. PowerPoint



Business Software



Project management software allows a user to plan, schedule, track, and analyze the events, resources, and costs of a project




Accounting software helps companies record and report their financial transactions



Document management software provides a means for sharing, distributing, and searching through documents by converting them into a format that can be viewed by any user

Enterprises typically require special computing solutions for various functional units



Specialty Software

Portable Document Format (PDF)

- ► A file format
- developed by Adobe Systems
- ▶ text, graphic, and formatting information
- from variety of applications on different platforms,
- used extensively on web

Specialty Software

Graphic File Formats

- ▶.jpeg (Joint Photographic Experts Group) images
- ▶.png (Portable Network Graphics) icons, transparency
- ▶.gif (Graphic Interchange Format) animation
- ▶.bmp (bit-map)
- ▶.tiff (Tagged Image File Formats) -high-resolution images to print




- ▶ social networks,



- ▶user guide
- ▶reference manual

Purchasing Software

- 1. Commercial Software
 - ▶ license must be purchased
- 2. Public-domain software
 - ► Not copyrighted legal to copy
- 3. Shareware
 - Copyrighted download for free, then pay if you use it
- 4. Freeware
 - Copyrighted -available for free or fee optional
- 5. Rentalware
 - ► Copyrighted leased

Licensed Software

- Site license
 - all computers at a specific location
- Concurrent-user license
 - specified number of copies
 - May have license-monitoring software
- Multiple-user license
 - number of people who use the software
- Single-use license
 - Limits the software to one user at a time

Other Software

- Pirated software
 - obtained illegally
 - violation of copyright
- Abandonware
 - no longer being sold or supported
 - 95 years copyright from date of publication
- Custom software
 - custom-made for company
