Lab 3. Contextual Design: Artefact Model

an artefact model is sometimes called an extend model with artefacts

This model expands upon the sequence model by incorporating artefacts such as digital screens, UI elements, or physical tools that users interact with during the task.

Work in pairs

Choose **one** of the following options and create an artefact model:

- **Website:** The model for a news website might have artefacts that show how users interact with various UI elements such as navigation menus, search bars, article previews, images, and social media sharing buttons.
- 1. **Phone App:** For a meditation app, this model could include example screenshots of the app's interface, highlighting buttons for starting and ending sessions, progress bars for tracking meditation time, and options for selecting different meditation tracks.
- 2. **Digital Tool:** In a task management tool, the model might incorporate screenshots of the user interface, showcasing features like task lists, priority tags, due dates, drag-and-drop functionality, and collaboration tools for sharing tasks with team members.

You may decide to use your own idea for a website, phone app or digital product or continue from previous lab work
