All ears

Meaning:

to listen carefully with full attention

Example:

When the teacher announced a surprise, the students sat up and were **all ears**.



By the book

Meaning:

following the rules very closely

Example:

The safety inspector followed the guidelines by the book to make sure everything was in order.



Caught red handed

Meaning:

getting caught while doing something wrong

Example:

Samantha was caught red handed eating the last piece of cake from the fridge.



Hang in there

Meaning:

not give up and keep going, especially during tough times

Example:

Don't give up! Just hang in there and keep trying, and you'll improve.



On top of the world

Meaning:

feeling extremely happy and successful

Example:

After winning the race, Sarah felt on top of the world, filled with joy and pride.



Take it easy

Meaning:

relax and not worry much

Example:

It's a weekend, so let's take it easy and relax by the beach.



Time flies when you're having fun

Meaning:

time seems to pass quickly when you're enjoying yourself

Example:

We were having so much fun that time flew by quickly.

Emily: "I have something to tell you."

Sarah: "Sure, go ahead. I'm all ears."

David: "How should I write this

report?"

Lisa: "Just follow the guidelines exactly as they're written. Do it by the book."

Jack: "Why were you taking cookies from the jar?"

Emma: "Oh no!. You caught me red handed."

Daniel: "How do you feel after winning the championship?"
